☐	Optional: a link to a film reel, short film, writing sample, portfolio, or other work sample that demonstrates the student's filmmaking growth and calling.
☐	I am applying for the 2026 academic year.
☐	I am applying for the 2027 academic year.

STUDENT LETTER PROMPT

Please attach a one- to two-page letter that addresses the following:

- Your personal testimony and relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Why you want to pursue Christian filmmaking.
- How you believe film can honor the Lord and impact culture for the sake of the Gospel.
- How you have demonstrated Lordship, Integrity, Teamwork, and Excellence in your school, film work, ministry, or personal life.
